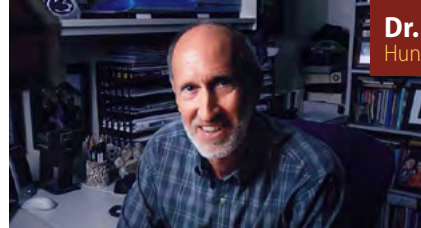

Key Dates in 325

- 1. May 20 Council opens**
- 2. June 14 Constantine arrives**
- 3. June 19 Nicene Creed adopted**
- 4. August 25 Council adjourns**

1700 years ago history was made in the Bithynian city of Nicaea, modern İznik. There the emperor

Constantine gathered hundreds of bishops and their assistants from the Eastern and Western parts of the empire. Why? To resolve a controversy raging in the church. Arius, a presbyter in Alexandria, was teaching that Jesus was created and not equal in essence with the Father. Constantine realized that this matter needed resolution to bring unity to his empire. In 325 the council decided that the teaching of Arius was incompatible with the teaching of Scripture, hence heretical. The bishops then issued a confession of faith today known as the Nicene Creed. Christians are gathering in Nicaea in 2025 to remember this historic moment and its ongoing spiritual significance for the global church. The other six ecumenical councils also took place in Turkey so our visit will include not only Nicaea, where the 7th council took place as well, but also Constantinople and Chalcedon (İstanbul) where four other councils were held. Lectures by historians and theologians will explain the background of each council and its importance in church history. Join us for this event which happens only once every century.

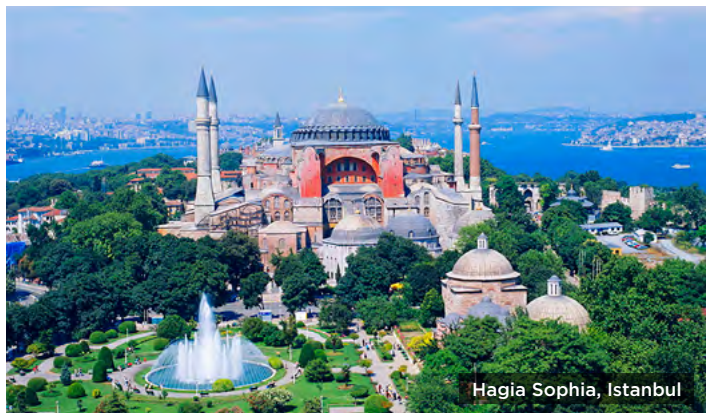

June 15 Sun Nicaea - Lectures by professors on 1st and 7th councils.

Afternoon visit to the Underwater Basilica area with local archaeologists. Dinner and overnight at Wellborn Luxury Hotel Kocaeli. (B,D)

June 16 Mon Nicomedia - Istanbul

Drive to Nicomedia (modern İzmit): visit the archaeology museum, Diocletian's palace, Roman theater, city walls. PM drive to Chalcedon (modern Kadikoy) to see the excavations at Haydarpaşa, and St. Euphemia Church (by appointment). Dinner and overnight at the Moevenpick Golden Horn Hotel. (B,D)

June 17 Tue Istanbul - Lectures by professors on 2nd, 4th, 5th, 6th councils.

Afternoon private Bosphorus boat tour seeing both Asian and European shores of Istanbul. Dinner and overnight at the Moevenpick Golden Horn Hotel. (B,D)

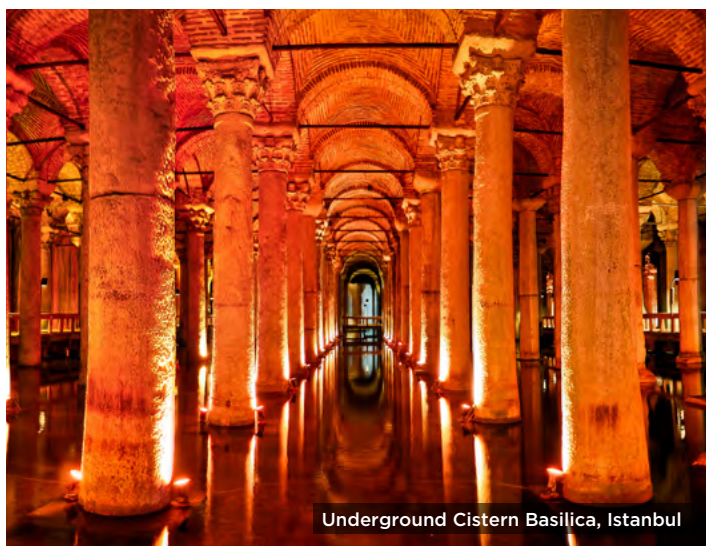

June 13 Fri Istanbul Tour of Constantinople (modern İstanbul)

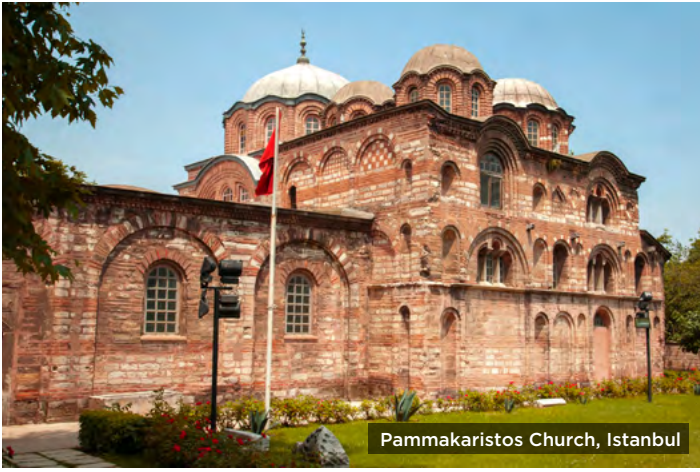

June 19 Thu Morning flight to Cappadocia

Meet and transfer to Ihlara valley to see the painted churches, visit Guzelyurt, and Caesarea (Kayseri). Dinner and overnight at the Hotel in Cappadocia. (B,D)

June 20 Fri Cappadocia - Closing
